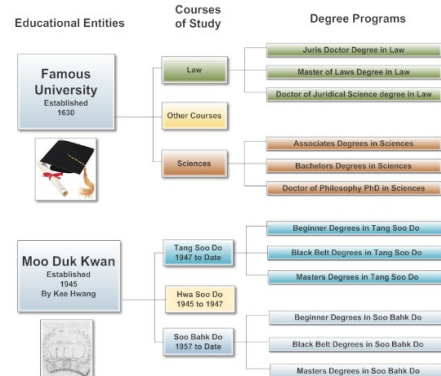


## Headquarters records indicate that you are time eligible to apply for the Moo Duk Kwan® 2021-2020 Ko Dan Ja Shim Sa.

We hope this letter finds you and your family in good health and spirits, Based on Federation records you are time eligible for the 2021-2020 Ko Dan Ja Shim Sa which is tentatively scheduled in Midway, Utah Dec 3-10, 2021 at the Zermatt Resort.

**This is not an invitation to test** as you still need to provide additional information to move forward in the 2021-2020 KDJSS application process:

1. Make sure your membership dues, fees and account balances are current and in good standing
2. **Obtain a signed recommendation from your personal instructor.**

3. **Complete the online KDJSS questionnaire.** The paper questionnaire has been eliminated.

4. **Upload your required hyung videos** as your KDJSS pre-evaluation (new for 2021)

5. **Complete Your Background Check**

**Your submissions are due BEFORE APRIL 15, 2021**

Your questionnaire responses will be forwarded to Regional Officials and TAC Officials **after APRIL 15<sup>th</sup>** for the TAC's recommendation process and then final selections will be made about who shall be invited as 2021-2020 KDJSS Candidates. **Formal invitations will be distributed by the first week in May.**

To support 2021-2020 KDJSS Candidate preparation the Technical Advisory Committee will be scheduling educational Ko Dan Ja Shim Sa preparation seminars via Zoom and you are invited to attend when those dates and times are announced.

Visitor tracks and mature practitioner tracks are also planned at the Moment With Masters and Ko Dan ja Shim Sa should you just want to enjoy advanced training, but are not testing in 2021.
